# New Projects after Earthquake

- Infrastructure & Institutions (\$65m)
- Budget Support (\$30m) + 25 million from other donors
- Primary Education (\$12m)
- Community Reconstruction (\$15m)
- Community Housing (\$30m)
- Debt relief of \$39 million
- IFC investments \$49.6 million

# Pledges & Delivery



	World Bank pledge to Haiti	Already delivered (as of Sept. 30, 2010)
<b>New funding (IDA + trust funds)</b>	US\$130 million	US\$91 million
<b>Disbursements from new and existing projects</b>	US\$250 million	US\$107 million
<b>Private sector support (IFC)</b>	US\$60 million	US\$49 million
<b>Debt relief</b>	US\$39 million	US\$39 million
<b><i>TOTAL</i></b>	<b><i>US\$479 million</i></b>	<b><i>US\$286 million</i></b>



# Concrete Results



- House Finance Ministry, ensuring tax collection and salaries
- Assessed 200,000 buildings in Port au Prince
- Removed 90,000m<sup>3</sup> of debris from canals
- Provided food supplements to 200,000 children under 2
- Funded 175,000 children to attend school and fed 80,000 children a hot meal every day
- Completed 6 rural water supply systems, benefitting 37,000

# Support for Private Sector

- IFC Strategy: create jobs by supporting the development of a sustainable and inclusive economy in Haiti
- Since the quake IFC has made US\$49.6m available for investment transactions, together with Advisory Programs
- Projects: EURASIA mining, CODEVI garments, E-Power 30MW power plant, OASIS hotel, SOGEBANK
- Advisory (IFC & Donors): partial telecom privatization, study on ports, Special Economic Zones, SME banking and environmental training, housing microfinance, lease financing
